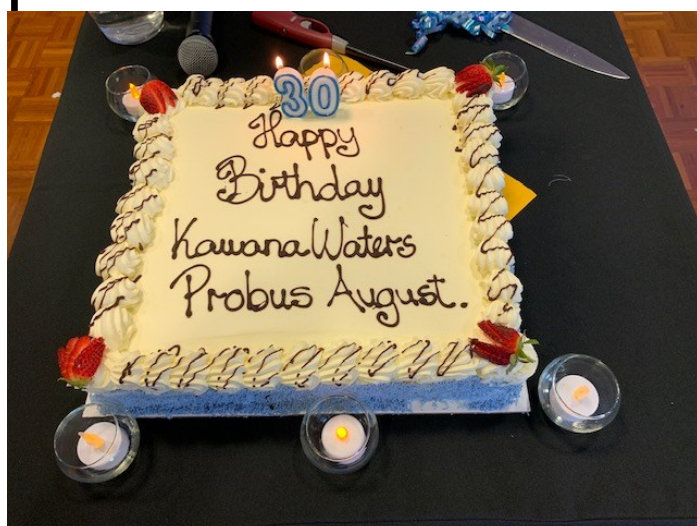

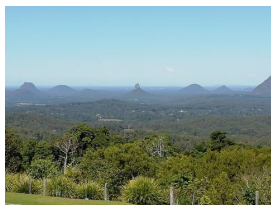

.Armchair Travel: John Roberts : Camino Portugues

A Power Point "Through my Eyes"

The pilgrimage from Portuguese lands to Santiago de Compostela in Spain originated in the Middle Ages. It was used by Queen Isabel of Portugal in the early 14th century. The route followed closely the ancient Roman roads of Lusitania but today on many stretches you walk along a modern road. This was experienced when leaving Porto so the party of four took the train for 10km to get out of the urban area.



The Portuguese Way is the second most popular camino in terms of numbers of pilgrims. While the whole Camino Portugues has its starting point in the capital of Portugal, Lisbon, where John, Janet and their friends embarked on this walk, most pilgrims start their trip from Portugal's second largest city, Porto or from the Portuguese-Spanish border town of Tui.

The stretch from Porto to Santiago has frequent pilgrim hostels and bars on the road and is quite busy with pilgrims. The route from Lisbon to Porto has less facilities and the waymarks are not that well marked but it can be done with more preparation.

The entire Camino Portugues from Lisbon to Santiago is 629 kms long but the part that starts in Porto is only 240 kms long.

This slide show was a very personal record of John's walk. He started out explaining how in the past the pilgrims carried 'burdens' either real or mental and John explained his 'burdens' being very personal problems among his friends. This made for a 'spiritual journey' for him personally.

The photography was wonderful and told, visually, the task that this group of four had taken on. Walking about 20km each day while carrying backpacks with 8 kgs plus 2 kgs of water. The accommodation varied at each stop – including two places with nights of luxury. Likewise the food varied but on the whole was good. This walk took 36 days.



John managed to get a video of the service at the end of this journey – he got great pictures of the massive thurible with its incense being swung overhead!
