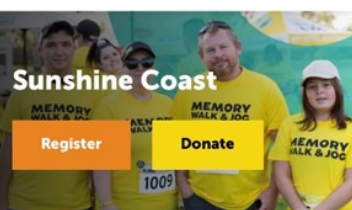

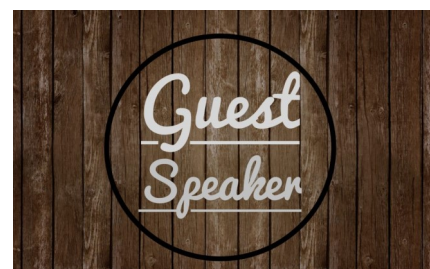
2021 Sunshine Coast course map

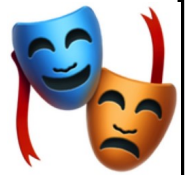

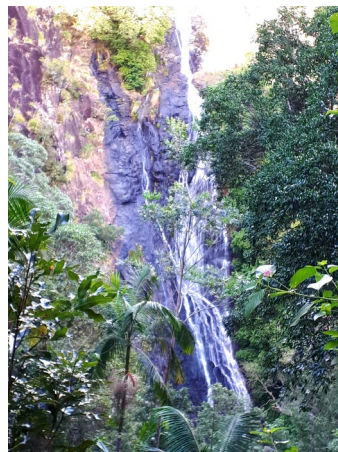
