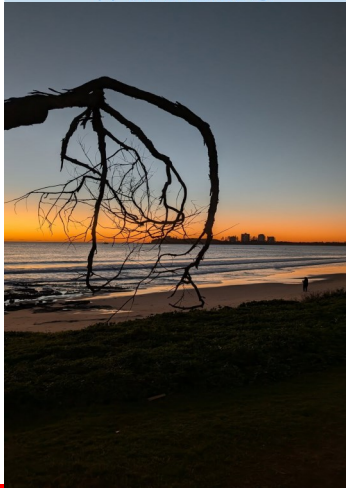

Also a reminder to current Badge holders to bring their Badge to the AGM.



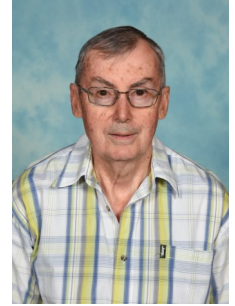
CINEMA SATURDAY

Hi Probus Members,

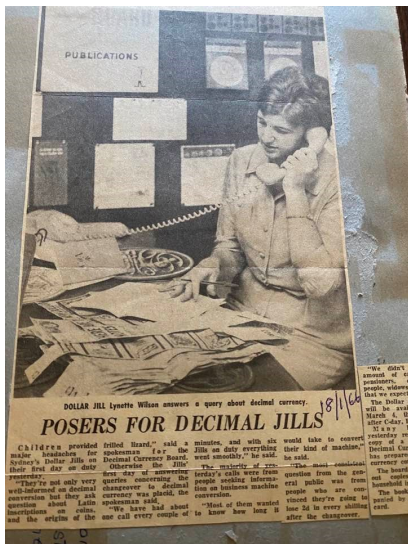
The current Probus year will come to an end in two weeks when we have the AGM. Where have those 12 months gone!

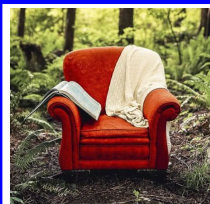

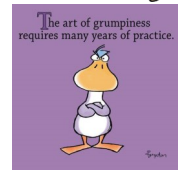

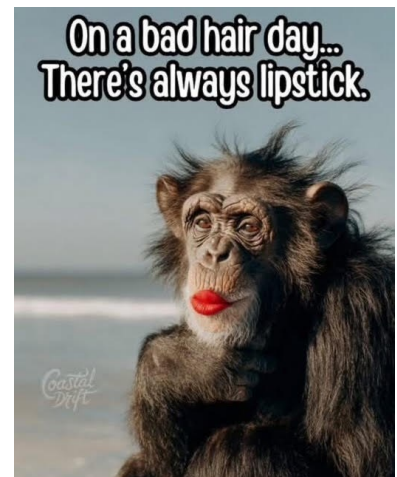
