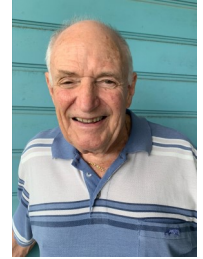

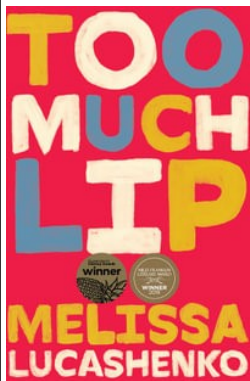

But now her Pop is dying and she's an inch away from the lock-up - fugitive with warrants out for her arrest in Queensland, she heads south on a stolen Harley. Kerry plans to spend 24 hours, tops, over the border. She soon becomes embroiled in dramas with regards to her family, her local family history & the development of the local community.

She quickly discovers, though, that Bundjalung country has a funny way of grabbing on to people. Old family wounds open as the Salters fight to stop the development of their beloved river. And the unexpected arrival on the scene of a good-looking dugai (white) fella intent on loving her up only adds more trouble - but then trouble is Kerry's middle name.

Gritty and darkly hilarious, Too Much Lip offers redemption and forgiveness where none seemed possible.

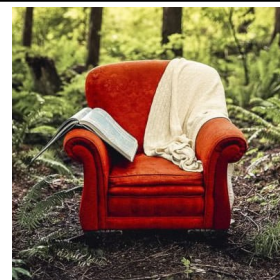

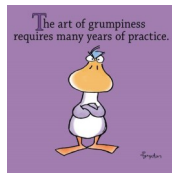

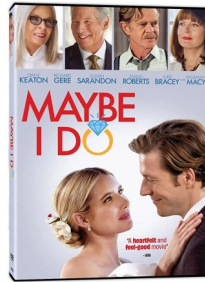
