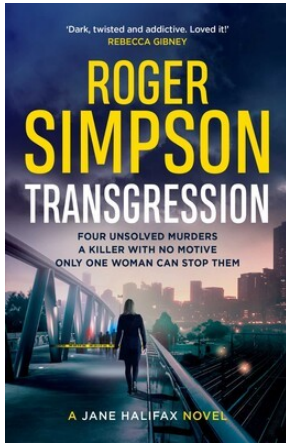
WEARING OF BADGES

His so called' friend reveals the motivation for his behaviour & connection to the victims, thereby incriminating himself as the accomplice. A page turner to the end!

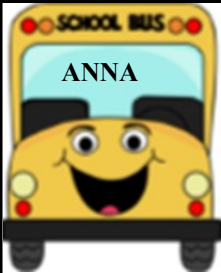

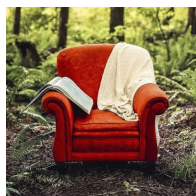

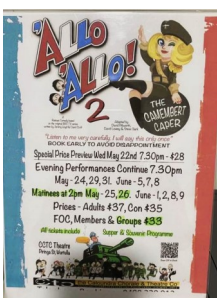

PROBUS THEATRE GROUP - ALLO ALLO (2) REVIEW.

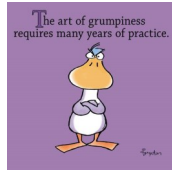

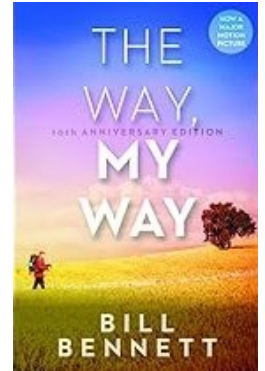


CONVENORS REPORTS FOR MAY 2024

Our Guest Speaker for the meeting on 14 May was Meg, Social Worker, from Cittamani.

Cittamani is a Palliative Care organisation founded by a Buddhist monk which provides care for people at the end stage of their life, either in their home or in a hospice. Its aim is to alleviate suffering and to that end it provides equipment for people in need, free of charge, and works closely with Palliative Care Specialists. It has been running on the Sunshine Coast for close to 30 years and 50% of its funding comes from the Queensland Government and 50% from public donations. Cittamani provides a valuable service for people in need, both the patient themselves and their family members
